ENO Treelympics calls children, youth schools and cities to plant trees

Faster. More. Stronger. The ENO Programme calls children, youth, schools and cities of the world to join ENO Treelympics, olympiads for tree planting. Our target is to plant 100 million trees by 2017.

ENO Treelympics will last 217 days, from 21 March to 24 October 2014. Participants plant trees and submit the information here with computers or mobile devices. Local communities are welcome to assist with seedlings, planting areas and preparatory work. Find areas that are big enough, suitable for tree planting and safe. Plant only trees species of local origin. If you plant different species remember to mention them when you enter the data online. From our map you can see information about trees planted with photos.



Each participant will receive ENO Treelympics Certificate. Due to large number of participants in team categories, one certificate will be sent to teams who will copy and deliver them to participants.

Awards will be given to three best participants in each category. One winner from each category will get a flight ticket to Finland for ENO Treelympics Award Ceremony, 20 November.

Environment Online- ENO is a global virtual school and network for sustainable development. Over 10 000 schools in 157 countries have joined its activities. ENO made a commitment in Rio+20 to plant 100 million trees by 2017. This pledge was highlighted in the overall summary of over 700 commitments made for Rio Summit.

We welcome our young generation to plant trees together and join this movement.
